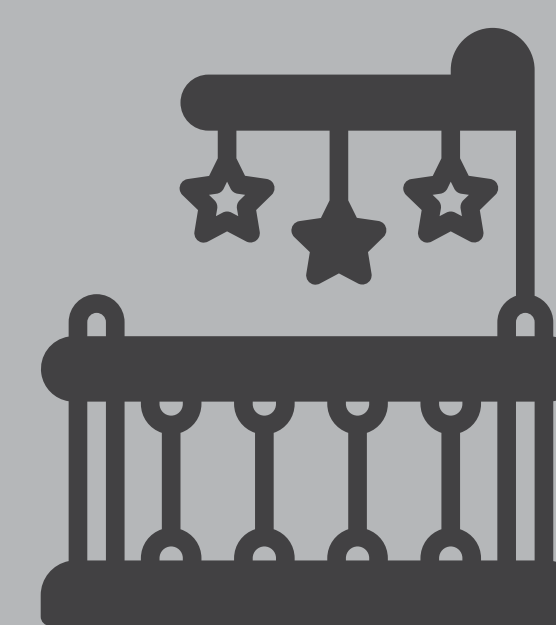

Jessica and her kids were one of the first families to move into Clare Place, New Moms' permanent supportive housing in Oak Park. "Having a place for my children and myself to be able to come home to and call somewhere home is more than I could have asked for. For them to have their own room, to have their own space, I'm so grateful to be able to give that to them." Jessica's family is partnered with a New Moms' coach, Paula, who is there to help them set and pursue their goals for the future. "New Moms has helped me in a lot of different ways—especially Paula," Jessica said. "She's been such a good help. She has helped me a lot with my mental health challenges and all of the things I've dealt with to get to where I am now. Paula encourages me, [...] she keeps inspiring me and keeps me going, making sure that I follow my dreams no matter how old I get or how many months pass."
