Developmental Milestones

Should I be worried that my child is not rolling over, sitting up, walking, talking, etc. at the same time as other kids? What should my child be able to do at this age? Is this behavior "normal?" Children come with lots of questions and developmental milestones are a way to find out some of the answers. Developmental milestones are easily identifiable skills that young children can perform. Children tend to follow the same progression through these milestones; however, no two kids go through these milestones at exactly the same time. Join us for this workshop to become more familiar with the major developmental milestones and learn how you can use them to support your child's development. You will also learn when and where you can go for developmental screenings and how to refer your child for a further evaluation.
